SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF THE CREATION OF NEW AFFILIATES

PURPOSE

San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby notifies the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) of the creation of new affiliates as defined in the Commission's Affiliate Transaction Rules (Rules).

BACKGROUND

In accordance with Commission Decision No. (D.) 97-12-088, in OIR 97-04-011/OII 97-04-012, Appendix A, Rule VI.B, as modified by D.98-08-035, SDG&E is required to notify the Commission of the creation of any affiliate addressed by these Rules. Accordingly, SDG&E is hereby notifying the Commission of the formation of new affiliates as shown on the enclosed Attachment.

No unusual or unique circumstances exist that would require affiliate transaction rule implementation measures for the new affiliates beyond those already identified by SDG&E. Therefore, SDG&E will apply the provisions of its 2007 Compliance Plan Advice Letter 1905-E/1702-G to all transactions with the new affiliates included herein. If the Commission modifies or requires the modification of Advice Letter 1905-E/1702-G, SDG&E will apply all such changes, or the provisions of such amended plans, to the newly formed affiliates included herein.

This filing will not create any deviations from SDG&E's tariffs or cause withdrawal of service from any present customers.

EFFECTIVE DATE

SDG&E believes this filing is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition) pursuant to GO 96-B. Since this filing is being made in compliance with D.97-12-088, SDG&E therefore respectfully requests that it become effective on April 2, 2008, which is the date filed.

PROTEST

Anyone may protest this advice letter to the Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 20 days of the date this advice letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
