**SUBJECT: FORM CLEANUP – CRITICAL PEAK PRICING: CAPACITY RESERVATION
ELECTION AND EVENT NOTIFICATION**

San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) hereby submits for approval the following revisions to its electric tariffs as shown in enclosed Attachment A.

PURPOSE

This Advice Letter revises SDG&E Electric Form 144-0811, entitled "Capacity Reservation Election and Event Notification Form," to relocate the Event Notification and Future Communications Contact Information sections into two separate forms. As such, this Advice Letter establishes Electric Forms 144-0812 and 144-0813, titled "Event Notification Information" and "Future Communications Contract Information," respectively.

SDG&E has rearranged the original Form 144-0811 contents into three forms in order to streamline customer communications and increase the administrative efficiency of the Critical Peak Pricing program. SDG&E has not altered the original form language and considers the changes provided herein to be non-substantive.

This filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with any rate schedule or rule.

EFFECTIVE DATE

SDG&E believes this clean up specific Advice Letter is subject to Energy Division disposition and should be classified as Tier 1 (effective pending disposition) pursuant to GO 96-B. SDG&E requests that the tariffs proposed herein be approved effective March 25, 2009, the date filed.

PROTEST

Anyone may protest this Advice Letter to the California Public Utilities Commission. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and must be received within 20 days of the date this Advice Letter was filed with the Commission. There is no restriction on who may file a protest.
