UDC Meter Services for Non-Direct Access Customers

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all customers who receive Default UDC Services as defined in Rule 25, Transitional Bundled Service (TBS) as defined in Rule 25.1, and Community Choice Aggregation Meter Services as defined in Rule 27. Electric meters eligible for service under this schedule may be owned either by the customer or the UDC. Customer-owned meters eligible for service under this schedule must be interval data recorders (IDRs). The UDC will continue to be the primary provider of all energy services, including commodity, billing, and meter-related services. Service under this schedule shall be taken in conjunction with the customer's otherwise applicable UDC rate schedule(s).

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All meter or retrofit devices installed under this schedule must be compatible with the UDC's existing meter reading systems. The UDC, employing the method it deems appropriate, must be able to extract the necessary usage or demand data to bill customers according to the customer's applicable UDC rate schedule(s).

TERRITORY

Applicable throughout the UDC's service territory.

RATES

Charges for services rendered under this schedule are listed under two categories of Meter Service Fees. One set of fees applicable to customers electing UDC-owned interval data recorder (IDR) meters, and another set of fees applicable to customers electing to either replace existing UDC-owned meters with non-UDC meters, or install retrofit devices or meter attachments to existing UDC-owned meters. Since services rendered under this schedule are not a part of services rendered under the customer's otherwise applicable UDC rate schedule(s), the charges under this schedule are in addition to the charges under the customer's otherwise applicable UDC rate schedule(s). Service fees listed under this schedule may change once every six(6) months, provided such a change results in at least a 10% change from the prior adopted fee.

OTHER CHARGES

Billing adjustments may be necessary to reflect changes in energy used in developing the transportation charges of prior periods. The minimum charges shall be the customer or service fees or the minimum bills of the otherwise applicable rate schedules. A late payment charge may apply to the customer's billing charges whenever the customer fails to pay for services rendered under this schedule. See Rule 9 for further details.

Meter Service Options for UDC-Owned Hourly Meters

The UDC will own, install, test, maintain, and read an interval data recorder (IDR) meter for customers electing the meter service options listed below. Each option listed below includes an IDR meter with varying degrees of communication capabilities. Except for telecommunication services, the individual services listed for each option must be taken together. For each option, the UDC will make available IDR load data information to the customer, or the customer's authorized agent. The fees for each option are in addition to the charges listed under the customer's otherwise applicable rate schedule(s). These fees will be assessed to the customer.

Meter Service Fees for Customer-Owned Meters, Retrofit Devices, or Meter Attachments

The UDC will install, test, maintain, and read the meter (for UDC billing purposes only) for customers electing the services listed below. The customer must provide to the UDC an IDR meter or retrofit device or attachment compatible with existing UDC meter reading systems. The UDC must be able to extract the necessary usage data from these meters for UDC billing purposes. An IDR meter not compatible with existing UDC meter reading systems may be used in conjunction with a Dual Socket Adapter. Both the IDR meter and the Dual Socket Adapter are provided by the customer. A meter credit may apply only to customer-owned meters. The fees for each service are in addition to the charges listed under the customer's otherwise applicable rate schedule(s). Unless otherwise stated through special contract provisions, these fees will be assessed to the customer.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Definitions. The definitions of principle terms used in this schedule are found either herein or in Rule 1, Definitions.
2. Service Rules. Service under this schedule is subject to the terms and conditions established in the UDC's existing rules and rate schedules for electric service.
3. Non-UDC Meter Ownership. Service under this schedule allows the customer to own the meter. A third party may provide meters to a customer, but the UDC will consider any non-UDC meter at the site to be the customer's property and responsibility.
4. Required UDC Meter Services. Service under this schedule requires that the UDC will continue to be the sole provider of meter installation, maintenance, testing, and meter reading services for UDC billing purposes only.
5. Subsequent Meter or Device Modifications. The customer, or the customer's agent, is prohibited from making any subsequent modifications to the meter, retrofit devices, or attachment(s) that will disrupt or distort the billing data required by the UDC.
6. Split Loads Not Allowed. Customers electing service under this schedule may not partition the electric loads of a single meter among electric service options offered by the UDC. The entire load of a single meter must be nominated for service under this schedule or any of the electric restructuring service options available to customers.
7. Meter and Schedule Availability. Service under this schedule is subject to meter and scheduling availability.
8. No Recalculation of Load-Profiled Electric Energy Commodity (EECC). Service under this schedule does not recalculate EECC as determined under the customer's otherwise applicable UDC rate schedule(s) for bundled UDC service customers.
9. Terms of Service. Service under this schedule will have a minimum one-month term of service. Service under this schedule will automatically renew for subsequent one-month periods. The customer must provide the UDC with at least a 15-day advance written notice of a change in service, with the exception of TBS customers. Service under this schedule will automatically terminate upon: (a) the day the customer notifies the UDC of its intentions to return to regular bundled UDC meter services, or (b) the day the customer begins electric services as a Direct Access customer as defined in Rule 25 and Rule 25.1.
10. Service Agreement. Customers who elect service under this schedule may be required to complete Form 143-00212 (1/99), Service Agreement between the Customer and San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) for Optional UDC Meter Services.

UDC Meter Services for Non-Direct Access Customers

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 11. Service Termination. Customers of record with the UDC must provide written notice to the UDC for termination of services provided under this schedule, with the exception of TBS customers. In the event the customer terminates services provided under this schedule and returns to regular bundled UDC meter services, the UDC will replace, at the customer's expense, the existing meter with a meter that is appropriate to provide regular bundled UDC meter services under the customer's applicable service schedule(s). The UDC will ship the meter to the owner of record at the customer's expense. Where the meter is a UDC-owned meter with an attachment or retrofitted device, the customer is responsible to restore the meter to it's original condition and return it to the UDC. The restoration and return of the UDC-owned meter will be at the customer's expense.
- 12. Abandon Equipment. The customer, or the customer's agent, must provide the UDC with written notice of any plans to abandon ownership of equipment to the UDC. Such written notice will be included with the customer's notice to terminate services under this schedule and return to regular bundled UDC meter services. The UDC reserves the right to assume or reject ownership of the customer's, or customer agent's, equipment.
- 13. Responsibility for Payments. Unless otherwise specified in the Service Agreement, the customer is responsible for the payment of UDC charges for services rendered under this schedule.
- 14. Disputed Bills. All disputes between the UDC and customers shall be subject to California Public Utilities Commission jurisdiction. Procedures for disputed bills are in Rule 10, Disputes.

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
