SERVICE FROM LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FACILITIES - BORREGO
(Closed Schedule)

APPLICABILITY

Applicable, in conjunction with any other applicable schedule, to service supplied from the utility's existing liquefied natural gas facilities in the Borrego area. This schedule is closed to 1) applicants for gas service at locations not supplied with gas service prior to January 1, 1984 and 2) load to be added to non-domestic customers requiring any change in utility facilities.

TERRITORY

Within the Borrego Rate Area. Rate areas are listed in the Index of Rate Area Maps.

RATES

Facility Charge:

Domestic Use..... \$14.79 per family accommodation per month.
Non-Domestic Use..... 5.480 cents per month per 1,000 Btu per hour of connected load

Commodity Surcharge, all usage, cents per therm..... 16.571

The commodity surcharge reflects charges to be added to the volumetric rates of the customer's applicable schedule.

Minimum Charge:

The Minimum Charge per meter per month shall be the Facility Charge plus the minimum charge designated in the applicable schedule.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Contract. A contract guaranteeing the payment of the minimum charges for a period of three years may be required for the initial service at each location under this schedule, provided that if the customer desires to terminate service and to assign the initial service contract, the assignee shall thereupon accept the assignment and shall assume and shall succeed to all of the rights and obligations of the customer under such contract. A contract guaranteeing the payment of the minimum charges for a period of one year may be required from customers taking service at a location where service has previously been supplied for two years or more. After the initial period, the contract shall continue in effect until terminated by written notice by one party to the other.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS (Continued)

- 2. Termination of Contract. Except as provided in Special Condition 1 above, if a customer desires to terminate the contract prior to the expiration of the initial term, the unpaid balance of minimum charges for the remainder of the contract period shall become due and payable unless the customer has arranged with the utility for the assignment of the contract or the execution of a superseding contract for the remainder of the period.

In the event that a customer terminates service under this provision prior to the end of the contract period and pays to the utility the minimum charges for the remainder of the contract period, the utility shall refund amounts, not exceeding such advance minimum payments, equal to the amounts collected from subsequent customers at the same location during the remainder of the original customer's contract period. Such refunds will be made once each year.

- 3. Subsequent Extensions. No extensions will be made after January 1, 1984.
- 4. Other Special Conditions. The Special Conditions of the other applicable schedules used in conjunction with this schedule shall also apply except that Special Condition 2 of Schedule G-91 will not apply as the utility cannot always guarantee to turn on or reconnect service within four hours of the request.
- 5. Connected Load. The connected load to be used for the purposes of determining the facility charge shall be the summation of the input capacities, expressed in BTU per hour, of the gas appliances connected to the utility's gas supply except that where a customer has both a gas-fired space heating system and a gas-fired air-conditioning system only the space heating system or the air-conditioning system, whichever has the larger input capacity, will be included in the calculation of the connected load. The connected load shall be determined by contract or by a subsequent load check. When the use of gas is seasonal or intermittent, no adjustment will be made for a temporary discontinuance of service or reduction of connected load. If service is resumed for the same customer or load within twelve (12) months after being disconnected, the customer will be required to pay all charges which would have been billed if the temporary discontinuance of service or reduction of connected load had not been made.
